

# CASEUF Summer Program 2018

As of 26 March 2018

**Period of Session:** 3 August 2018 – 17 August 2018

**Organizer and Host:** Fukuoka Women's University

**Number of Students:** 30 students (20 from ASEAN and EU; 10 from FWU)

**Nomination of Participants:** CASEUF full member institutions are asked to nominate participants. The responsible office in each full member institution is asked to submit their nominees' application materials to the FWU International Center by 31 May 2018.  
2 places are reserved for nominees from each CASEUF member. A JASSO scholarship will be also granted to each of those 2 students.

**Eligible Students:**

- must be enrolled in the CASEUF full member institutions;
- must be in good academic standing with a grade point average of 2.3/3.0 or higher (see below for JASSO grade point average scale);
- must be proficient in English for academic purposes (at least TOEFL iBT61 or the equivalent); and
- must be a female.

**Participation Fees:** 30,000JPY

**Other expenses:**

- Wi-Fi router (if you need): 2,000 JPY for two weeks (refundable with returning in no damage)
- Dormitory IC-key card: 2,000 JPY (for a loss)
- Dormitory room key: 7,000 JPY (for a loss)
- Dormitory desk key: 5,400 JPY (for a loss)

**To receive a JASSO Scholarship:** Recipient will receive a scholarship in Japanese yen in the program orientation. According to the requirement by JASSO, all JASSO scholarship recipients have to submit a "Completion Report" and answer "Feedback Questionnaire" by the deadline. Forms will be provided by FWU.

**Travel Expenses Subsidy:** This subsidy may cover return-trip airfare between the international airport nearest to a participant's home university and Fukuoka Airport for participating in the program. Maximum 100,000 JPY will be granted
