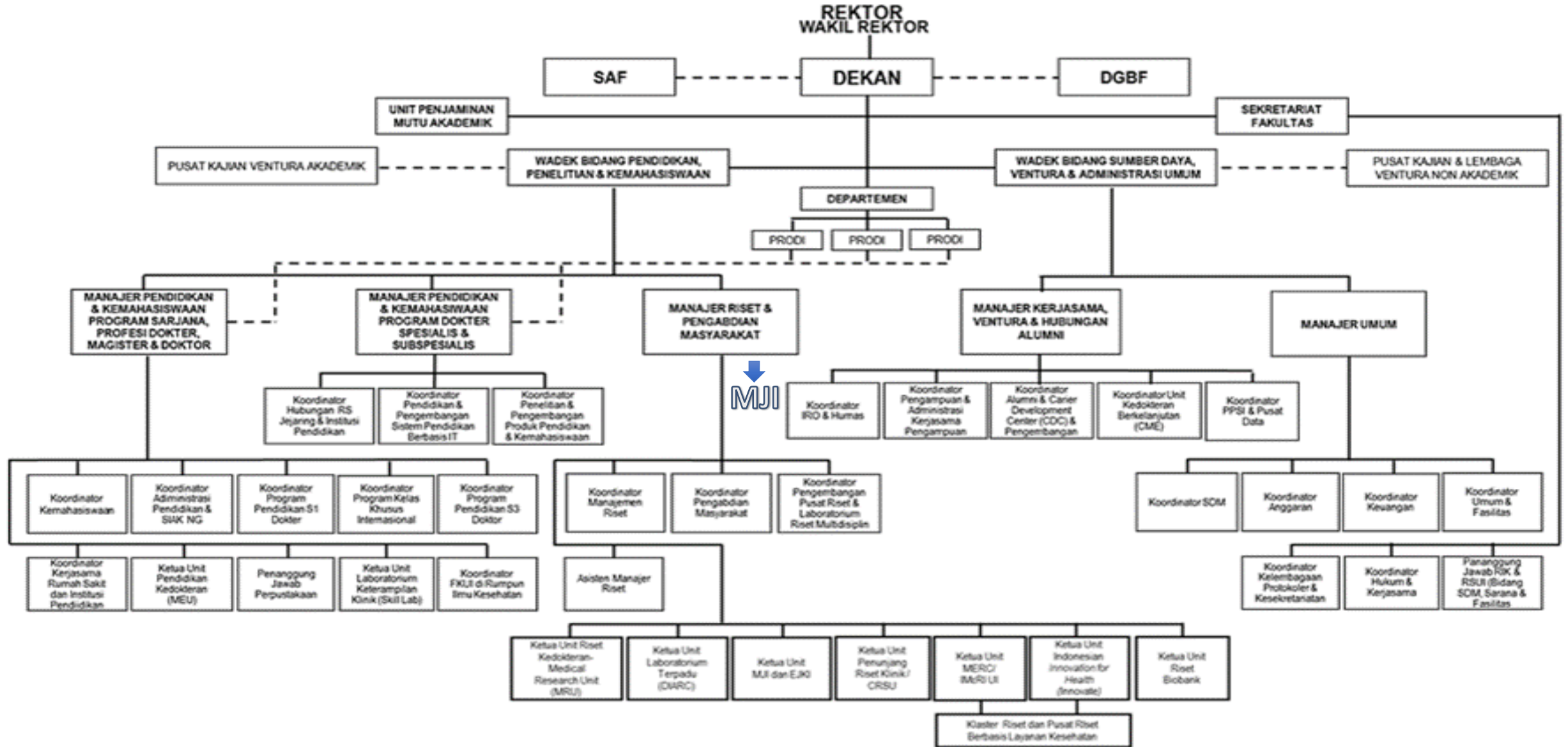

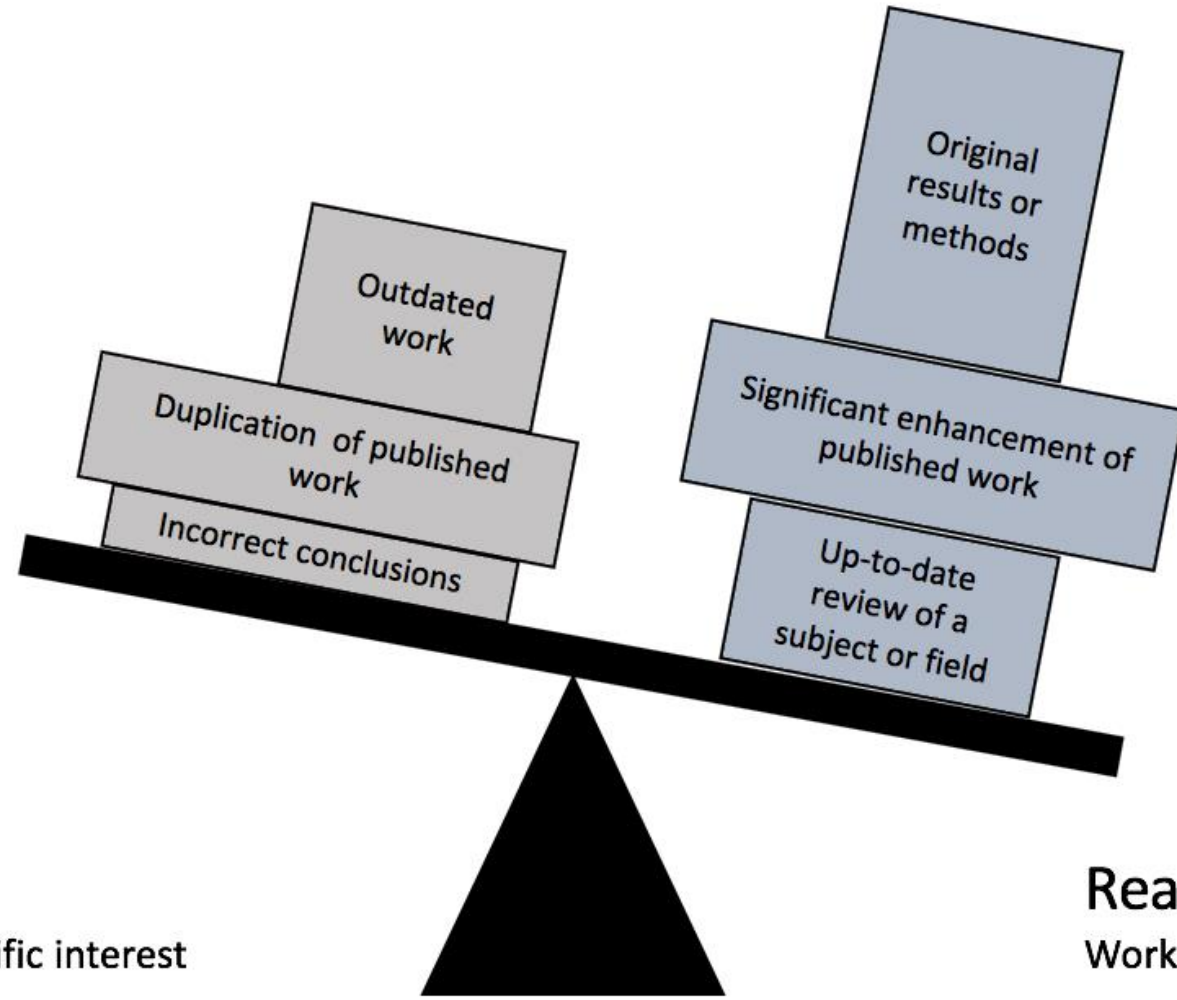

- ◆ Navigation is the Next Big Thing:

- ◆ There is simply too much information available

- ◆ And too little time to search it all

- ◆ On the web, in databases, in libraries

- ◆ Scopus will supply researchers with workflow tools that increase their productivity

This is a well presented Indonesian multidisciplinary medical journal, published in English. **Unfortunately, the content is weak.** Greater subject specialisation and strategic partnership with other regional journals would almost certainly help raise standards and widen the content to an international readership and authorship.

If in the future these comments are addressed, you may decide to submit a new application at any time after the following date: October 2014.

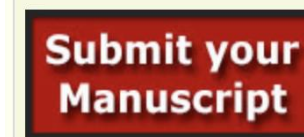

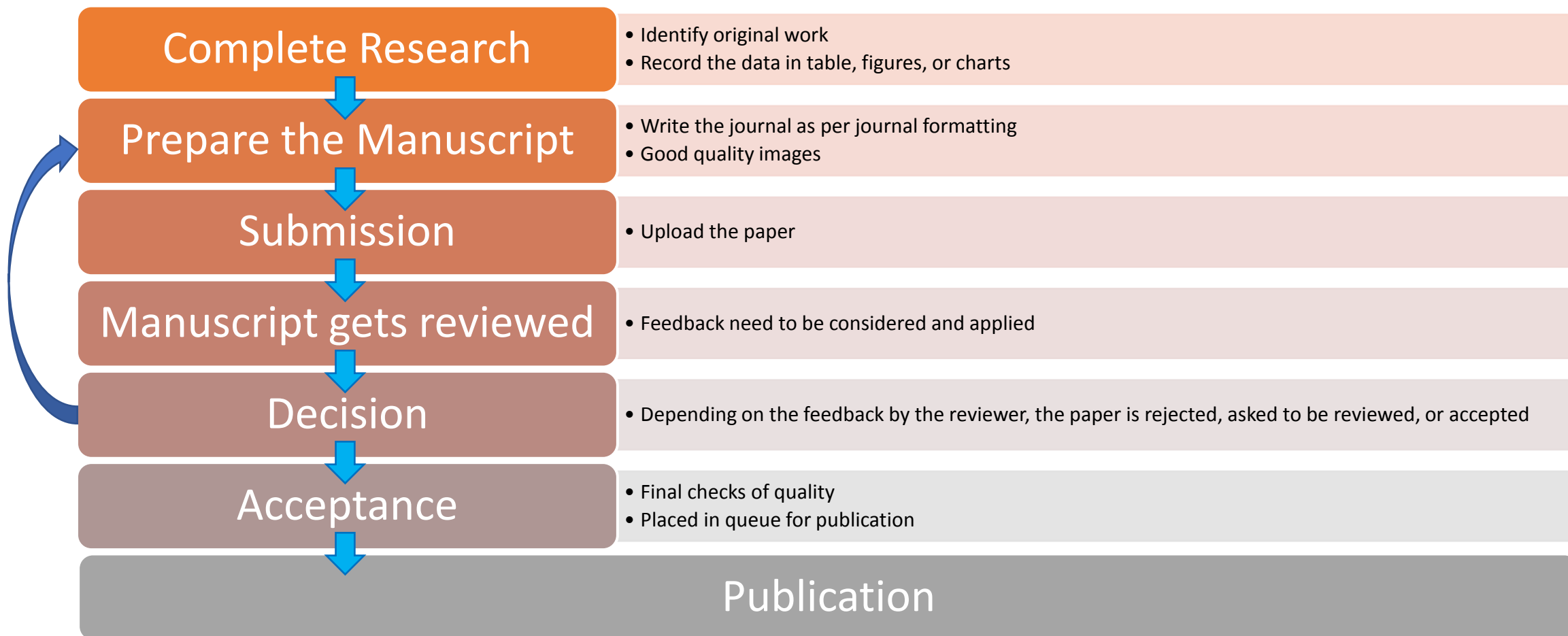

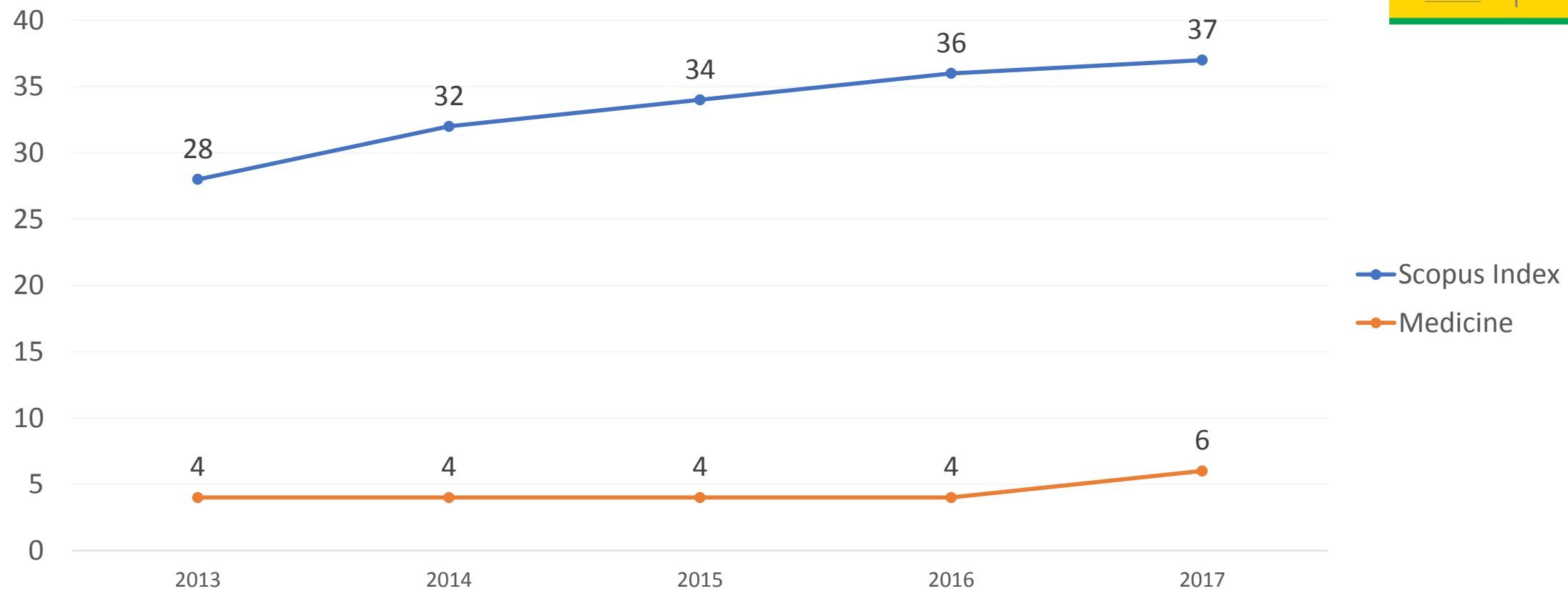

Weakness and Solution

Weakness	Solution
Does not have reviewer	Having collaboration with others to increase the reviewer
Limited English language	Every department (Clinical Surgery, Internal Medicine, Gastroenterology, etc) has reviewers to review about the language, methods, and also contents
Limited journal publication	Most article from dissertation and thesis → upload into MJJ → indexed in Scopus

The Important of Language

Poor language quality can delay or block publication of work

The reviewing process

Peer review

- Helps to determine the quality, validity, significance, and originality of research
- Helps to improve the quality of papers
- Publishers are outside the academic process and are not prone to prejudice or favour
- Publishers facilitate the review process by investing in online review systems and providing tools to help Editors and Reviewers



What is it?

Peer review places the reviewer, with the author, at the heart of scientific publishing

Reviewers make the editorial process work by examining and commenting on manuscripts

Without peer review there is no control in scientific communication

Reviewers are the backbone of the whole process

The most serious issues to avoid

These are the 3 most common forms of ethical misconduct that the research community is challenged with:

- 1. Fabrication**

Making up research data

- 2. Falsification**

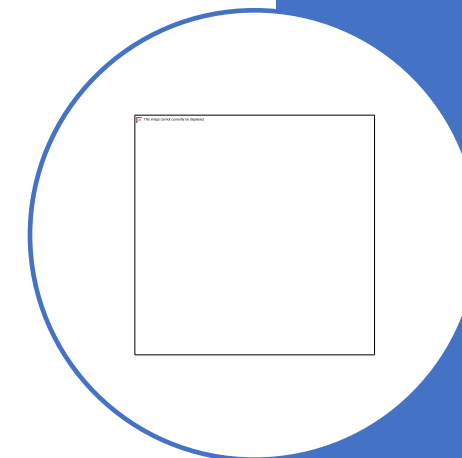
Manipulation of existing research data

- 3. Plagiarism**

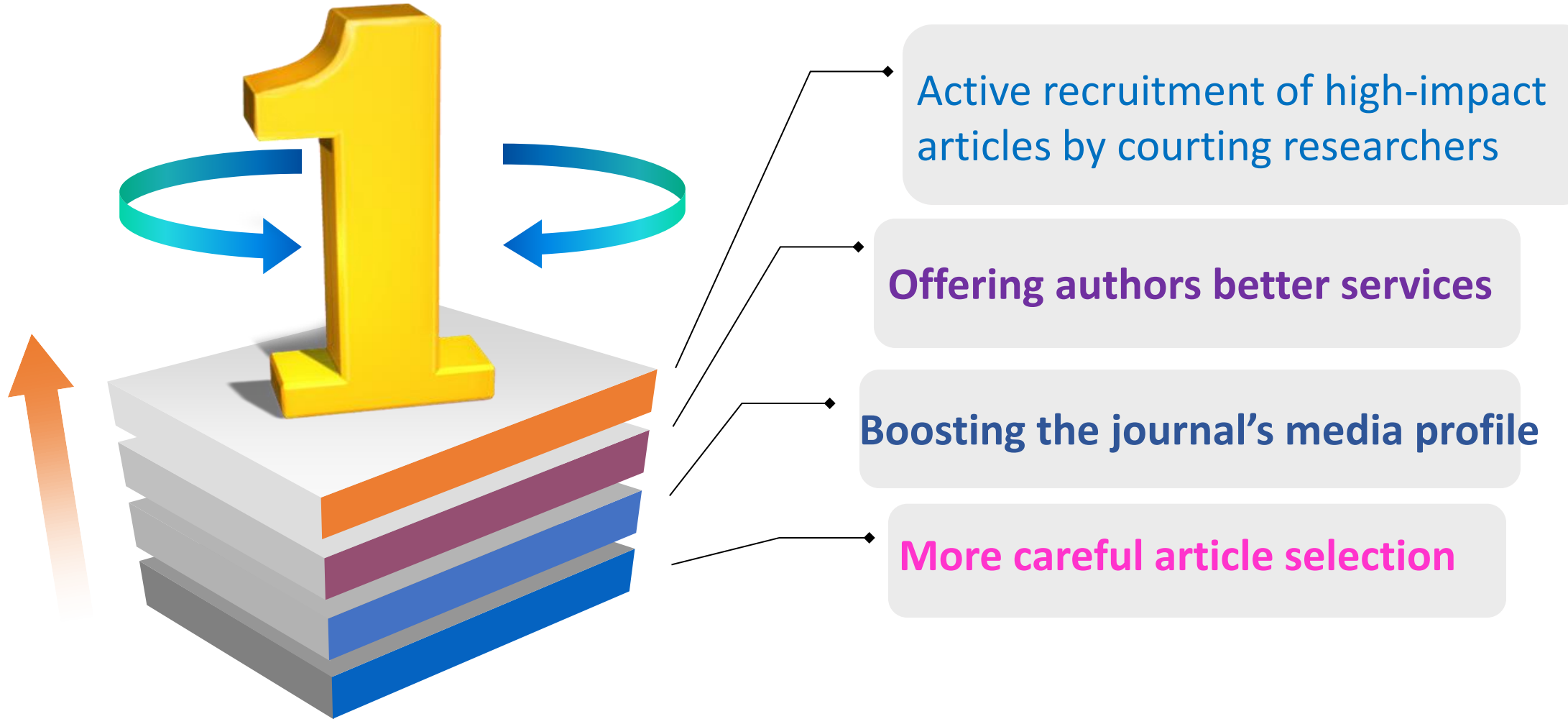
Previous work taken and passed off as one's own
