



**Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital, Mahidol University Announcement of  
Medical Charge Calculation for Foreign Patient of Siriraj Hospital  
BE2561 (2018)**

To efficiently and appropriately implement the medical charge collection for the foreign patient of Siriraj Hospital, as agreeable to the policy of Economic Commission, Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital

Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Mahidol University, as empowered by virtue of Section 37 of the Mahidol University Act B.E 2550 (2007), Dean, by approval of the Board of Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital Meeting number 22/2560 on Tuesday 19 December BE2560 (2017), has announced the criteria and regulation on Medical Charge Calculation for Siriraj Hospital, as follows

1. In case of any dispute arising from other announcements, this announcement shall be final.
2. In this announcement,
  - “Faculty” means Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Mahidol University,
  - “Dean” means Dean of Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Mahidol University,
  - “Foreign patient” means
    - (1) alien who does not obtain Thailand’s national identity card, or
    - (2) one who obtains Thailand’s national identity number beginning with 6, 7, 8, and 0.
  - “Foreign patient” excludes
    - (1) one who receives medical service and is able to provide any proof of Thai nationality,
    - (2) one who grants a work permit from the Department of Employment, the Ministry of Labor, and obtains Thailand’ health security scheme,
    - (3) alien who obtains Thailand’s universal health-care coverage scheme,
    - (4) international lecturer of Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital,
    - (5) international advisor of Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital,
    - (6) international student or trainee of Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital,
    - (7) international student or trainee of Mahidol University,
    - (8) official invited foreign visitor of Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital, and
    - (9) official invited foreign visitor of Mahidol University
  - “Alien” means One who does not grant Thai nationality
  - “Identity Card” means Official identification document issued by the government of Thailand to certify Thai nationality of those who grants the document
  - “Hospital” means Siriraj Hospital
  - “Medical Treatment” means
    - (1) management and care of a patient to treat disease or disorder physically or mentally and the physician infers that the treatment is necessary unless the patient’s health will be in danger,
    - (2) general medical examination, diagnosis, treatment, rehabilitation, and regular health checks,
    - (3) pregnancy care and childbirth,
    - (4) acute care for trauma or accident,
    - (5) dental care, and

(6) cosmetic surgery  
“Medical Charge”

means a fee for outpatient service, inpatient service, regular clinic service, or after-hours clinic service, the patients required to pay to the hospital; the medical charge includes

- (1) medication fee, medical supply, blood and blood substitute, food supplement, oxygen supply, and other relevant supplies,
  - (2) artificial organ, and medical device, and its maintenance fee,
  - (3) medical treatment fee, diagnosis and clinical laboratory fee, pathology fee, medical imaging fee; excluding additional service fee, i.e. extra surcharge for overtime service or extra care service,
  - (4) medical equipment
  - (5) procedure fee, and anesthesia fee
  - (6) room and board fee,
  - (7) relevant treatment service fees, and
  - (8) doctor fee and after-hours clinic surcharge
3. The medical charge for the foreign patient is 25 percent increased from the standard medical

charge.

4. Other matters regarding foreign patients follow the foreign patient care procedure.
5. An alien who is considered as the foreign patient in this announcement consists of
  - 5.1 alien who receives the medical treatment and is unable to identify his/her nationality during the treatment, and
  - 5.2 alien who receives the medical treatment and is in a nationality verification procedure, unless the alien is able to provide the proof of nationality and his/her healthcare benefit or social security right. In case those foreign patient has already been overcharged despite the fact that he/she has the right to grant the waiver, the department in authority has to submit the request for the reimbursement to the Office of the Director of Siriraj Hospital case by case.
6. In case of any dispute arising from this announcement, the judgment of the Dean, or Hospital Director shall be final.

This announcement is valid from April 2<sup>nd</sup>, BE2561(2018) onwards.
