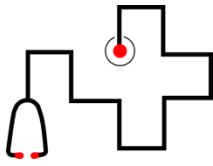


# Introduction

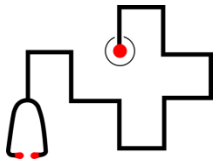


- Public university in Oregon

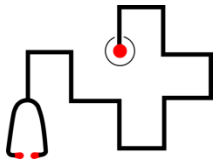
# Objective and expectation

- Learn more about health system within USA and drawback from their system.

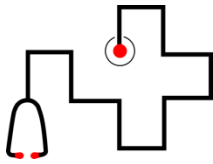

- They has more staff and medical care providers and that make less workload than ours.

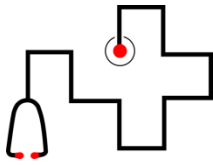
# Benefits
