







• Public university in Oregon


• Main campus, located on Marquam Hill in the southwest Portland




Objective and expectation


- Learn how to manage BMT patient in the different way and bring back any new way of treatment or new medications that can further develop to Siriraj BMT unit

- Learn more about health system within USA and drawback from their system.













- Most of the medical recording system were electronic which made it very easy for data management and also very useful in term of research data gathering
