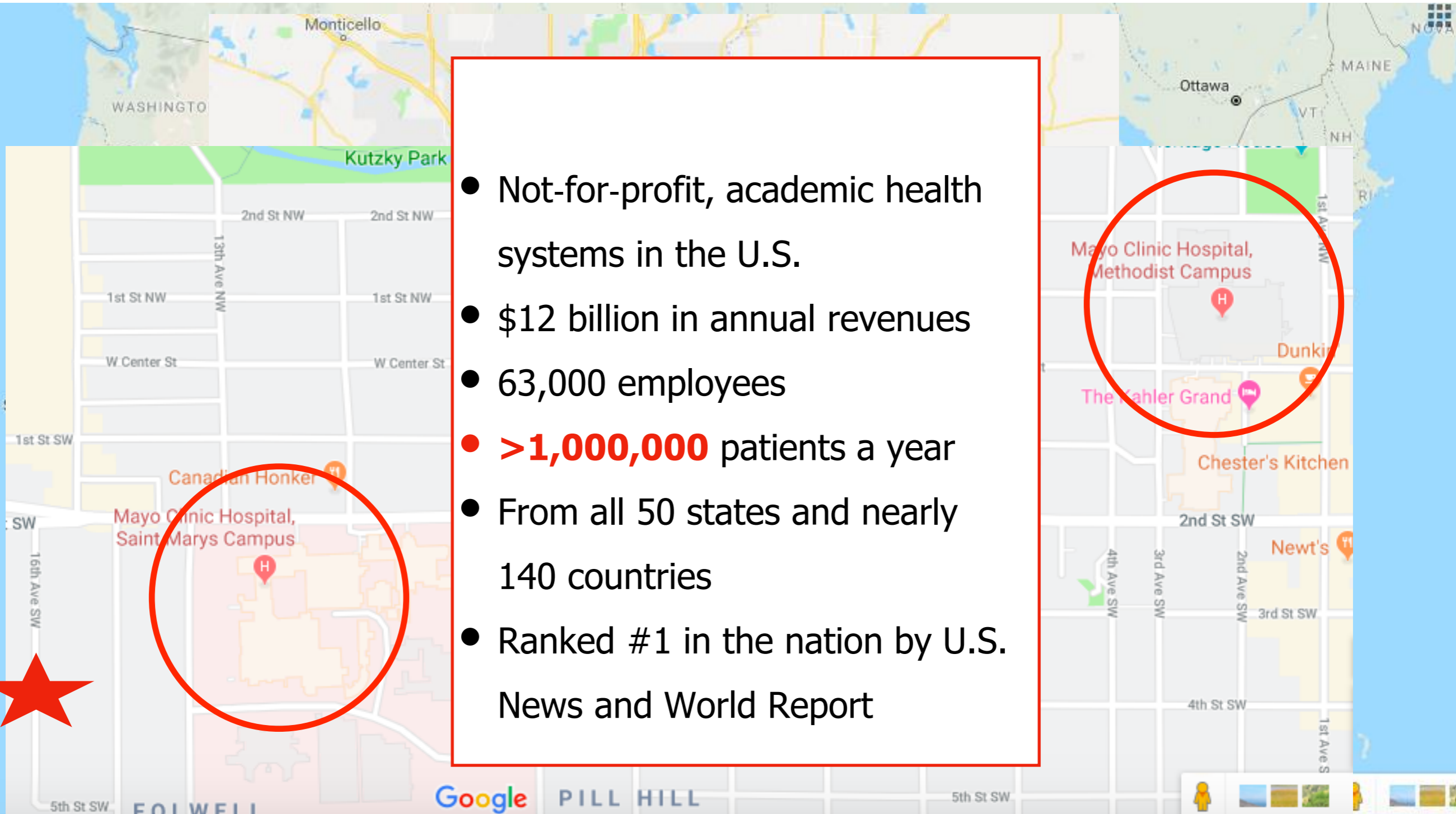

- Ranked #1 in the nation by U.S. News and World Report





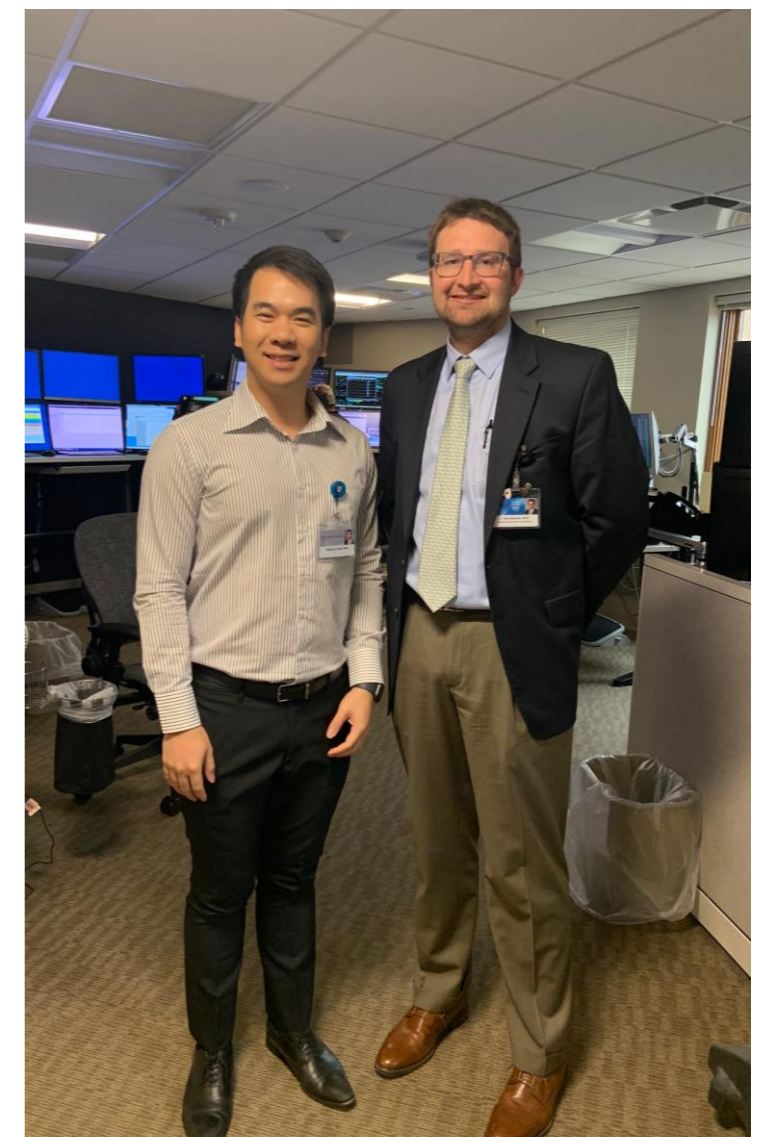
Expectation and Objectives
