Purpose:

The IASP and WFSA Clinical Trainee Fellowship is aimed to deliver practical clinical training in pain management for the resources limited countries.

Eligibility Requirements:

	The trainee will generally be a physician of two particular specialties namely, Anesthesiology and Physical & Rehabilitation, who has at least 3 years experiences in his or her career.	
	The trainee must be a member of IASP/or WFSA or must apply for membership upon award of the fellowship.	
	The trainee must serve as a staff member in resources limited countries in the same region of the training institute.	
	The trainee must not be IASP/or WFSA awardees Fellowship trainee within the last 3 years.	
Guidelines:		
	One 12-month fellowship is available	
	The clinical training is under supervision of the mentors which includes anesthesiologist and rehabilitation medicine specialist.	
	They will be asked to complete at least two or three original case study and/or one review article.	
	They will be involved in direct patient under supervision of mentor.	
	There will be opportunities to study in several aspects of pain management as directed in the program content, face to face, and hand- on treatment of regional blockades, acupuncture and psychological method of treatment of pain, palliative care, and rehabilitation.	
	The Committee on Clinical Training will evaluate applications according to:	
	 Oualifications of the applicant 	

- o The usefulness of the training to the applicant's clinical career.
- Application will be scrutinized by the IASP/ WFSA

	 Applicants should be supported by letters of recommendation from at least two referees with appropriate professional background such as anesthesiology, rehabilitation medicine. 	
	IASP/WFSA will disburse the awards to the host institution at the start of the training and after acceptance of responsibility for the training of the applicant	
	Upon completion of the fellowship, the trainee must submit a report to the IASP/WFSA describing the clinical practice and skill performed and training received.	
	IASP/WFSA will receive a report from the training institution indicating that fellow has satisfied all training requirement including evaluation by an externa assessor.	
	The trainee must acknowledge the IASP/WFSA Trainee Fellowship in publications arising from work started or completed during the training period and must send copies of the publications to IASP/WFSA.
