






#### Artwork Submission

- 1. All content in the work must be in English.
- 2. All files from the Public Health International Competition are submitted in PDF format and collected in one file with the name :

- 3. The folder is sent via email phicfkmunair2021@gmail.com with the email subject : Submission for Essay/Paper/Infographics Public Health International Competition 2021
- 4. The folder contains :
  - a. Work
  - b. Letter of originality → advisable to include an agency stamp at the leader's signature
  - c. Scan of identity card in jpg or jpeg format
  - d. Other requirements that explained in the specific term of each competition

 If participating in a group, the artwork is sent by only one representative to the email above.


#### Artwork Submission

- Artwork submission is submitted at the same time as registration ; don't forget to screenshot your submission for uploading the evidence of submission in the registration form.
- 7. Late submissions will not be tolerated and graded by the judges.
- 8. Artwork submission is allowed once only. The committee did not accept the submitted work revision with ANY reason.
- 9. All fraud in this competition will result in reduced scoring and disqualification.
- 10. The decision of the jury is final and inviolable.
- If there are changes or additions, the provisions and other information that have not been listed above will be regulated by the committee at a later date.

#### General Terms & Condition

- 1. All artworks must be made according to the theme.
- 2. All artworks must be originally made.
- 3. If there is proof of plagiarism, participants will be immediately disqualified and registration fee will not be returned.
- 4. All artworks must be written in English
- 5. All artworks must not be submitted ever in another competition be it the past or present.
- 6. Participants are only allowed to submit their artwork once.
- 7. Mistakes by negligence of participants will not be tolerated.
- 8. All artworks must not contain any racial slurs and curse words also specific views of certain politics and or groups.
- 9. All decisions made by the judges are final and absolute therefore unalterable.

#### Terms & Condition : Essay



- 2. Participant each team consists of 2 (two) students and 1 (one) tutor/supervisor from the same school.
- 3. Essay submitted is original (original and not plagiarism) which has never existed, been published and have never won an event before and are not sent to other competition events.
- 4. The length of the essay is between 2.000 to 3.000 words, contains :
  - a. Introduction
  - b. Content
  - c. Closing
- 5. Essay Format:
  - a. File name :

Name of the Leader\_Agency/Institution\_Competition Category\_Tittle of Work (Example: Astrid Prameswari\_UNAIR\_Essay\_Covid-19 Detection Tool in Improving World Health Status)

- b. Essay Title, written in Times New Roman, 12 point, and bold.
- c. Font (for essay content) : Times New Roman size 12 point
- d. Margin : 3 cm on all side, except 4 cm for the left side ; justify
- e. Line spacing : 1,5
- f. Paper size : A4

#### Terms & Condition : Essay



- 6. Criteria and Aspects of the Essay assessment (40%), are:
  - a. Idea (25%) : creativity, feasibility implementation, actualization of the selected topic and focus of analysis
  - b. Script format (10%) : writing, language, format compatibility
  - c. Resources (5%) : sources suitability, information accuracy

The remaining 60% will be calculated from the presentation in final.

- 7. Images or graphics can be included in Essay writing
- 8. Essay must contain citations with Harvard style
- 9. All content in the work must be in English.
- 10. Essay must be typed and submitted in PDF Format with the name : Name of the Leader\_Agency/Institution\_Competition Category\_Tittle of Work (Example: Astrid Prameswari\_UNAIR\_Essay\_COVID-19)

#### Terms & Condition : Paper



- Participants eligible to participate in the paper competition are university students (either bachelor degree or associate's degree), evidenced by a scan of the student identity card.
- Participants in the paper competition should be in teams of two (2) or three (3) from the same agency/institution. The number of teams includes the leader.
- 3. Participants must write a paper.
- 4. All types of papers are allowed as long as it does not violate any rules and laws.
- 5. Paper format is as follows ;

a. File name : Full name of the

Leader\_Agency/Institution\_Paper\_Paper Title

(Example: Astrid Prameswari\_UNAIR\_Paper\_COVID)

- b. Font : Times New Roman size 12
- c. Margin : 3 cm all sides, except 4 cm for the left side ; justify
- d. Line Spacing : 1,5
- e. Paper Size : A4

Aspects of the paper assessment (40%) are ;

a. Idea (25%) : creativity, feasibility implementation

b. Script format (10%) : writing, language, format compatibility

c. Resources (5%) : resources suitability, information accuracy The remaining 60% will be calculated from the presentation in final.

- 7. The paper must be written about 20 pages maximum (excluding cover, table of contents, figures, tables, or attachments).
- 8. Paper must contain citations in Harvard style.
- 9. All content in the work must be in English
- 10. Paper must be typed and submitted in PDF Format with the name : Name of the Leader\_Agency/Institution\_Competition Category\_Tittle of Work (Example: Astrid Prameswari\_UNAIR\_Paper\_COVID-19)

#### Term & Condition : Infographic

- Participants eligible to participate in infographics competition are between ages 16 - 23 years old.
- 2. Participants in the infographic competition can register individually or in teams of two (2).
- 3. Participants must use digital illustrations.
- Participants are allowed to use software or applications (such as Corel Draw, Photoshop, Canva, etc) as long as it does not violate copyright laws.
- 5. Participants are allowed to use any style of illustration.
- 6. Illustration format: A3 (42 X 29,7 cm), resolution 300 dpi or more
- 7. The work must include the PHIC's logo and it is allowed to include a logo/name of agency/institution.
- 8. Participants are required to make a description of the contents of the infographic on one A4 size page, with the format: Times New Roman, font size 12, spacing 1.5, (left margin 4 cm, right 3 cm, top 3 cm, bottom 3 cm)., and accompanied by Harvard style references.
- 9. All content in the work must be in English.

#### Term & Condition : Infographic



- 10. Aspects of the paper assessment (40%) are;
  - a. Content (15%) : originality, suitability of themes, content (informative, actual, and accurate), grammar and tenses
  - b. Visualisation (25%) : clarity of fonts (size, type, color), illustration of images and graphics, color selection, layout
    The remaining 60% will be calculated from the presentation in final.
- Infographics must be typed and submitted in PDF Format with the name : Name of the Leader\_Agency/Institution\_Competition Category\_Tittle of Work (Example: Astrid Prameswari\_UNAIR\_Infographics\_COVID-19)
